Americans can say that today, even about ourselves?

I'm just about 50 years old and was not born until a few years after World War II. My father's only brother was a U. S. Marine who was killed in combat, fighting for an obscure island in the Pacific. My father did not let us forget the sacrifice so many Americans made during that horrible period of human history. We should never forget that America saved the world from global dictatorship. The Soviet Union was ready to collapse as was England. American industrial power kept them supplied and in the war. Had they been forced to surrender, Japan and Germany would have linked up and literally encircled the world. Germany was working on atomic bombs and missiles while the Japanese were developing biological weapons. There is little doubt of what would have happened if they had prevailed. Many of today's history revisionists are blind to what World War II was all about. They see W.W.II from the vacuum of their own perspective and sell it to our children, propaganda masquerading as education. My children will never forget the sacrifices our fathers made for us. If we all make a commitment to tell others the truth and ask them to pass it on, then perhaps their memories will never die.
